Dear Parents and Carers,

We are all feeling extremely proud of our pupils over the last two weeks. They have returned to school after a significant period of time at home, full of enthusiasm, smiles and willingness to achieve and learn. The resilience they have shown throughout this pandemic has be amazing. As you will see below, we have had some huge successes this week.

Home testing is going well, staff are testing twice a week prior to coming into school. This is enabling us to identify asymptomatic cases. We have a small number of pupils testing in school, where this can be carried about independently. 
