COVID FAQ's September 2020



Are children expected to wear school uniform?

Yes, all children are expected to wear full school uniform

Has the curriculum changed?

No, our curriculum will remain the same there will be no omissions. Timetables will come home during the first week.

Can parents come into school?

No. At present we are asking parents to use eschools or contact the school by email or phone

Does my child have to return to school?

Yes, unless they have an extension to shielding this can be discussed with the headteacher

Will school be running after school clubs?

No, not for the first half term, we will review after this.

Will there be hot lunches available?

Yes, there will be a full hot lunch service for pupils, we encourage all pupils to have a hot lunch to limit food products coming into school. Where a child requires a packed lunch please use a disposable carry bag to put this in.

Will my child need a bag?

We are asking parents to limit what pupils bring into school, all stationary will be provided.

Will my child need their PE kit in Primary?

No, primary PE will be done outside or in classrooms, but no changing will be required, this will be reviewed at half term.

Will my child need their PE kit in Secondary and Sixth Form?

Your child's teacher will be in contact with further information regarding PE kits.

Will my child need their swimming kit?

Yes, all children will require their swimming kit.

Groups will be swimming in class bubbles. There is additional cleaning times between groups using the changing rooms.

Does my child require Face Coverings

Face coverings at Primary are not required.

Face coverings at Secondary and Sixth Form are advised in corridors and other busy, crowded areas (not in classrooms) in MAINSTREAM SCHOOLS. Due to the nature of our school and having individual areas for all bubbles we are not expecting crowded areas and therefore we are not requiring pupils to wear face coverings.

Staff will wear full PPE for changing and feeding pupils as per our policy. Staff also have the option to wear PPE including face coverings in and around school.
