National Trust

A parent has offered the following information to be shared: *I follow a group on Facebook regarding DLA - Disability Living Allowance tips and advice. If a parent receives DLA for their child, they can join the national trust for £10 per child, per year (as a gifted junior membership) and with this comes an "essentials companion card" that admits two carers for the child that is disabled. It is valid for 2 years and is renewable. We have just got an annual membership for 2 adults and 3 children, one of whom gets DLA for £30 total, instead of approx £94 per annum. All you have to do is ring the membership line and state you receive DLA for your child on 0344 8001895. Its really worth it. We had a lovely afternoon out at Tatton Park this weekend. You do have to book in advance online though. Hope this helps out any other parents/carers.*
