In essence the Stay Up Late campaign fights for the rights of people with a Learning Disability/ Autism to stay out later at night. We want to support this. Following successful funding from the Community Lottery Fund we are able to offer sessions for SUL.

All members of TOG can book onto sessions in the usual way. However, we will try to ensure we are fair to all members, so we will operate a waiting list system. With over 120 members, If you have already been on one of the sessions, you may have to wait until other members have accessed these sessions. We are limited to six members per session. This is part of the funding criteria, and we want to keep to smaller groups.

If we need to provide accessible transport, we will try our best to do so, where possible, Transport costs are included for each session. You can also choose to make you own way to the activity. For any personal care or mobility support you will need to provide this. If we have to include more care support staff on sessions, we may have to reduce the number of member spaces.

The costs of the sessions will vary depending how much they cost. They will range between £12 and £20. If the activity is over £50, for example a concert, we may price these slightly higher.

We will confirm you are booked on in the usual way.
