The Green in the Corner is a safe community space at the heart of Hurdsfield. We have 2 rooms and a garden at the rear. The library area is big enough to host groups of 12+ with a toilet and kitchenet, large fold down tables and chairs are available. We have plenty of books, jigsaws, games, craft materials and toys for all ages to use during your visit or you can bring your own equipment. The 'café' area seats 12 people with a disabled toilet, including baby changing area and fully functioning kitchen. **Parking is available outside the shops on Hurdsfield Green, next to the flats. A ramp is available on request.**
