

Supported Adults Service - One Minute Guide

Our Vision is for children & families to START WELL, adults to LIVE WELL & older people to AGE WELL.

At Wishing Well, we're proud to offer a high-quality, structured programme for adults aged 18+ with autism and/or a learning disability.

Each supported adult has a timetable designed around their individual needs, interests, and goals. Through one-to-one mentoring and group sessions, we help our guests to strengthen their communication, develop life skills, and feel connected to their community.

Our weekly programme brings together social connection, wellbeing, physical activity, and environmental projects. We currently deliver our services across seven venues, creating opportunities for guests to take part in meaningful in-house volunteering. We are proud to offer unique experiences that enables people to contribute to their community, while building the skills, confidence and practical experience needed to move towards employment.

We place great emphasis on independent living skills, with practical sessions in cooking, cleaning, ironing, washing, and home safety — all designed to build confidence and support daily life. Training in money management, personal safety, literacy, numeracy, and IT helps individuals gain transferable skills that promote independence and prepare for future opportunities.

We head out & about on our minibus on day trips to explore new places, and enjoy shared experiences beyond our usual venues.

The service operates Monday – Friday 10am to 3pm @ The George's Community Hub, West Street Crewe, CW2 8SL.

Our guests pay for the service using Direct Payments, although some pay privately. Direct Payments are put in place through Cheshire East Council, Adult Social Care. You can contact adult social services on 01270 371382 or speak to your social worker to find out if you are eligible.

Once an assessment of needs is completed by the social worker, we carry out our own assessment to make sure our service is able to meet the needs of our guests who must be able to manage their own personal care independently.
