## Maths:

## Computing:

## English:

**Chronological reports:** Produce a report called 'My day out...'

This could include a day shopping, visiting family, going to the seaside, going to the cinema. What did you do? Write a report putting in order all the things you did that day.

## Science:

**Sunset in a glass:** Fill a glass of water and add a tiny bit of milk, then shine a light through it to simulate how particles in the atmosphere make sunsets look red

**Hidden light sources hunt:** Go on a scavenger hunt to find both natural (sun, stars) and artificial (bulbs, toys) light sources around the home.

## Foundation Subjects:

**Design and Technology -** What items can we recycle? Help to do the recycling at home for one week. How many things has your house recycled?

**MFL -** would you like to try some foods from Spain? Why not look in the supermarket for tapas! Try some olives and frittata!

## Physical Activity/Well-Being:

Go for a walk and see how many types of flowers you can see. Don't forget to take some photos.

Try some yoga poses!

## PSHE:

Make a poster on the topic

**'Healthy Living'** include what foods you need to eat to ensure you have a healthy, well-balanced diet. You could also make up a menu for someone including the healthiest ingredients you can find.
