Dear Parents and Carers,

We have celebrated the Queen's Jubilee today, and it will certainly be a day that won't be forgotten soon! The laughter, fun, singing, games and so much more has been so memorable. A huge thank you to the Friends of Springfield who have beautifully decorated the school for the occasion.

As you may have heard, our plans have been passed by the council on Monday for an expansion at Springfield on the Crewe site. At Cabinet on Monday the votes were unanimous, and we are all delighted with the outcome.

Places at Springfield are completely oversubscribed at present and we have large numbers of pupils requiring places within our locality. The expansion will be for an additional 80 places, which will be an additional 50 pupils as we are already 30 over our pupil allocated numbers and have some off-site provision.

You have our reassurances that standards will remain as high as ever; we have grown strong Leadership Teams, Teachers and support staff to enable us to feel confident in pursuing the expansion. We successfully had an expansion in 2019 with our new Springhigh block and expect this will be implemented with the same success.

As with any expansion there will be slight disruption however, due to the proposal being situated around the sports barn we do envisage this being minimal for our pupils.

We will look forward to welcoming everyone back on **Tuesday 7th June**.

Food Bank Appeal


Thank you to all parents and staff who sent in donations for St Pauls's Foodbank last week.
