Dear Parents and Carers,

Lots of exciting learning has been taking place this week, we haven't been able to run swimming this week due to staffing implications, but pupils have enjoyed alternative activities within the classroom.

We have experienced some difficulties with our transport system this week. We are needing to amend things slightly to ensure the safety of all of our children, staff and parents.

Parent drop off time will be 9.05am – 9.20am

If you need to drop your child off before this time you will need to park in the car park at the bottom of the road (this is a school car park, and you will not be fined for using this). You will then need to walk your child into school.

The reason for this is when we are doing school transport, we have to lock vehicles down, so they are not moving when children are getting off the bus.

If you are dropping your child off during 9.05am – 9.20am please ensure you take your child to one of the 3 entries:

SPRING HIGH

GREEN GATE

MAIN RECEPTION

Staff will receive your child at one of these locations, again this is for safety reasons. Please be mindful when leaving the car park, of other parents dropping off.

If you do need support getting your child from the car please park outside of reception where staff will be available to help. If this is full, please wait for a space to become available.

At the end of the day please collect from the same point.

I am sure you will all appreciate getting 213 pupils in school within ½ hour with over 35 vehicles is no easy mission – **we really appreciate your support in this matter.**
