To provide a specialist Behaviour and Therapy Support Centre which will be dual purpose to provide intensive behaviour support for identified pupils, alongside specialist therapy services to enhance the school offer to all pupils.

At Springfield we would like to offer a therapeutic approach in addition to the everyday personalised curriculum. The aim is that we would have a range of qualified and experienced in-house therapists who would assess the needs of children at Springfield and provide or source appropriate, individual and or group therapy.

The behaviour support centre would be a short-term intervention for pupils who have periods of time where they are struggling within the main school classes.  
This could be for bigger interventions such as:

- Behaviour
- Emotional Support

Or smaller interventions focusing on aspects of the day:

- Eating lunch / snack
- Home time
