## **Internet Safety**

#### Dear Parents/Carers

We would like to make you aware of the growing popularity of pupils recording their own videos and uploading them to platforms such as YouTube. These videos often include gaming content where children provide voice overs for characters, or game commentary to go with the action on screen. They mimic the style used by popular game vloggers on YouTube which the children may enjoy watching at home.

While this may seem like a harmless activity, please be aware of some safeguarding concerns.

Children should only access games appropriate to their age.

Pupils should not upload their faces onto the video.

Pupils should not use their own names or share any personal details on their videos.

Pupils can chat and record via their game consoles. This can be done without their friends knowing which may then result in private conversations being uploaded without the consent of all involved.

As always, we ask that as parents and carers you are extra vigilant and always supervise use of the internet with your children.
