Signposts for Building Better Behaviour

Attached are details of the "Signposts for Building Better Behaviour" which are being run by LD CAMHS. **Aims of the Programme**

- To work with families to:
 - Develop ways of preventing difficult behaviours.
 - Encourage more appropriate behaviour.
 - Teach children new skills.
 - Help to meet any new challenges in the future.
- To help parents/carers understand their child's behaviour.
- To enable parents/carers to work out why the behaviour happens.
- To build on parenting skills by increasing parents/carers confidence and preparing and practicing how parents/carers respond to their child's behaviour.
- To help families address behaviours that their children display, that they find difficult to manage.

The next Signposts course will be held via Microsoft teams.

The sessions will start at 10:00am and are estimated to finish at 12:00pm

The session will be held on a **Thursday** morning on the following dates –

Signpost course 1 - full

Signpost course 2 - Start 13 May 2021 - *Pre-measures, your team as a family and dealing with stress*

If any parents are receiving Ehips or Direct -payments and are looking for PA workers for their child, details are attached of two agencies recommended by Shortbreak team.


If you are considering support for the summer holiday, you are advised to start looking now as they do get booked up very quickly.


