SEND Survey

This week, we launched our annual parent carer survey aimed at parents and carers of those children and young people who have had an education health and care (EHC) needs assessment or an autism assessment with the NHS.

We want to know if improvements made to services during the last year have been seen and felt by parents and carers and ultimately improve the lives of children and young people with SEND across Cheshire East.

The survey opened this week and runs for four weeks with a closing date of Monday 8 February 2021.

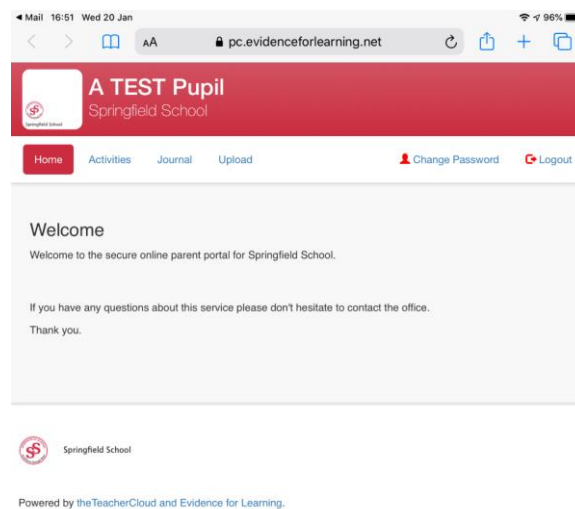
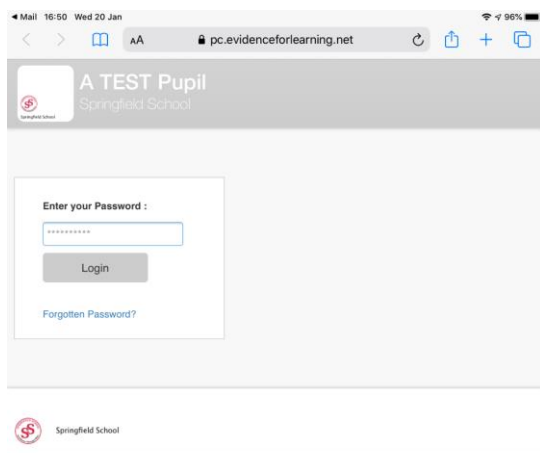

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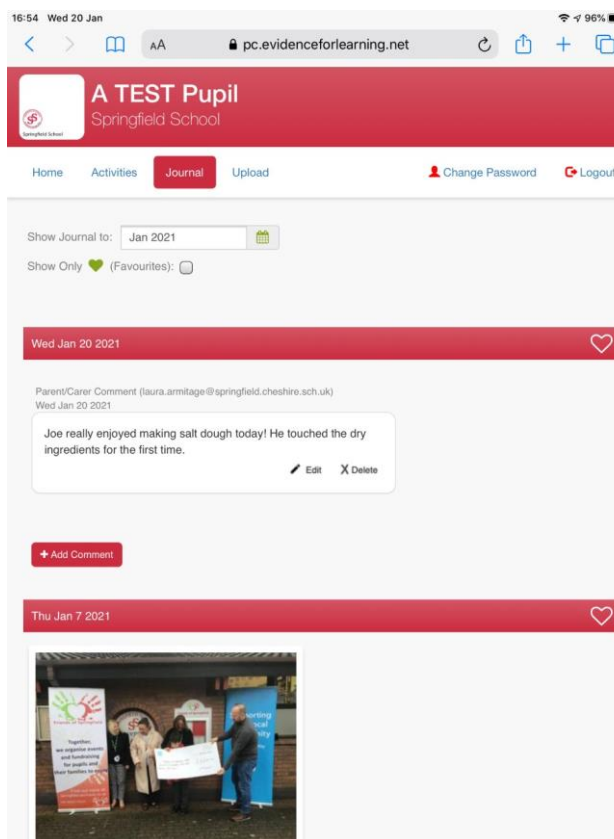
